



The following are general directions for the use and care of your new marching band plumes.

Your plumes are skillfully handcrafted in the U.S.A from domestically sourced natural and synthetic materials.

Important: Feathers are dyed with water bases dyes. Due to the nature of the dye, color fastness cannot be guaranteed. Try to avoid getting the plumes wet or damp. Wet or damp plumes can be gently wiped with a paper towel and must be allowed to completely air dry before they are stored.

To keep plumes looking their best, store plumes in plastic sleeves in their tubes away from moisture, heat and light. Phantom and Cavalier style plumes should be stored flat in their bags.

Plumes should be inserted or removed from headwear by the metal cup. Always handle plumes by the cup or looped wire base. It is important to note the direction of the feather when storing or removing the plumes from tubes. For Drooping or Fountain style plumes, always insert the top first and remove by pushing the plume through from the looped wire end. For Upright and Stickup plumes, insert the looped wire side first and remove by pulling the plume from the tube by the looped wire.
